Notes:

- *1 For definitions and measurement units see general notes on paramount peaks
- *2 Veliki Troglav is on the border of Croatia & Bosnia
The 3 peaks Mali, Sredni, Veliki Troglav are less than 1 km from each other
Mali (Small) T. is 1913 m, 1 m higher than Veliki (Big) T. which is 1912 m
- *3 Veliki Stolac is about 2 km from the border of Bosnia and Serbia on the Bosnian side
It is in the Republika Srpska area and appears in lists of Serbian mountains
- *4 2386 m high Maglic (BA-1, 43.276N 18.736E) on the border of Bosnia and Montenegro
is narrowly dominated by Bobotov Kuk
- *5 Vjetrena Brda and Crnoglav are near each other, height and position somewhat uncertain. Some sources give height (found by SRTM?) at widely quoted but incorrect latitude & longitude. Vjetrena Brda, at least 2020 m by Google Maps, is listed as 1689 by Geonames, 2076 m by Panoramio, 2222 m by Summitpost.
Crnoglav is at least 2060 m by Google Maps, 1844 m high by Geonames, 1724 m by Mapcarta
