Notes:

- *1 For definitions and measurement units see general notes on paramount peaks
- *2 Pancicev vrh (Milanov vrh) the highest peak of Kopaonik is near the border of Kosovo and Serbia, probably on the Serbian side
- *3 Kosovo has the Geonames code of XK, the FIPS code is KV
- *4 RS-2, KV-20 and RS-882 form an interesting chain.
RS-2 Pancicev vrh (2017m) dominates KV-20 Musinac (1725 m), which in turn, dominates RS-882 Sopot (1425 m).
As RS-2 itself does not dominate RS-882, if it was not for Musinac, Sopot would also be a paramount peak.
